



Before to add the script into Domotz, an API Key is required to access CONVERGENCE Local Agent to obtain the API key. After entering in CONVERGENCE portal, click on **Settings**

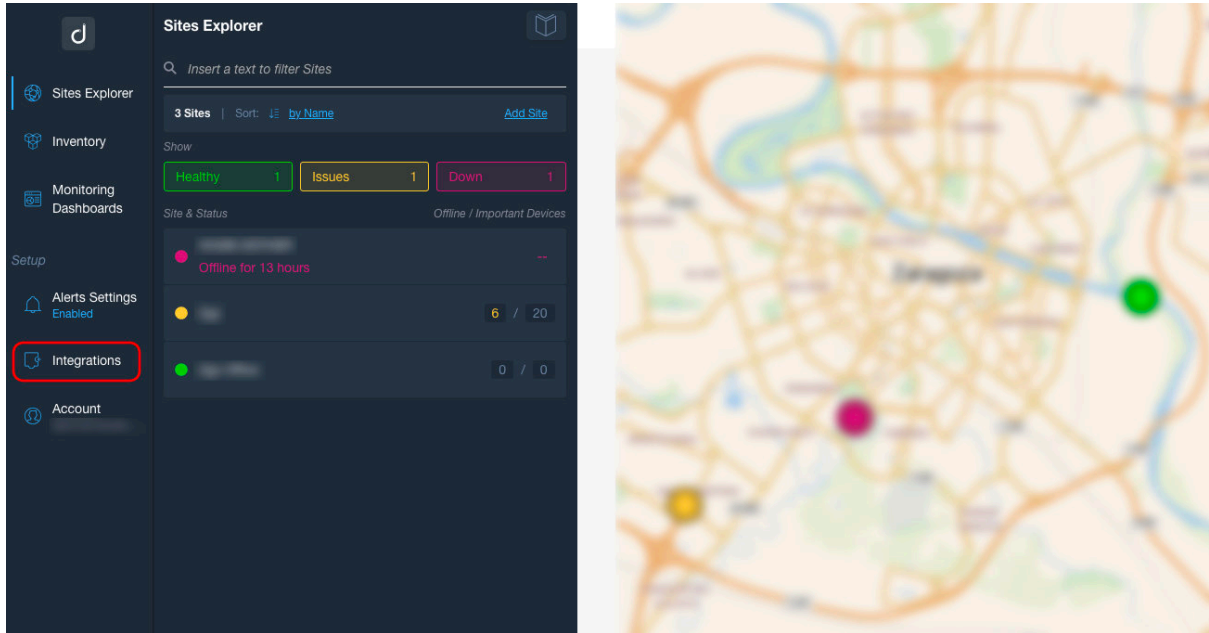

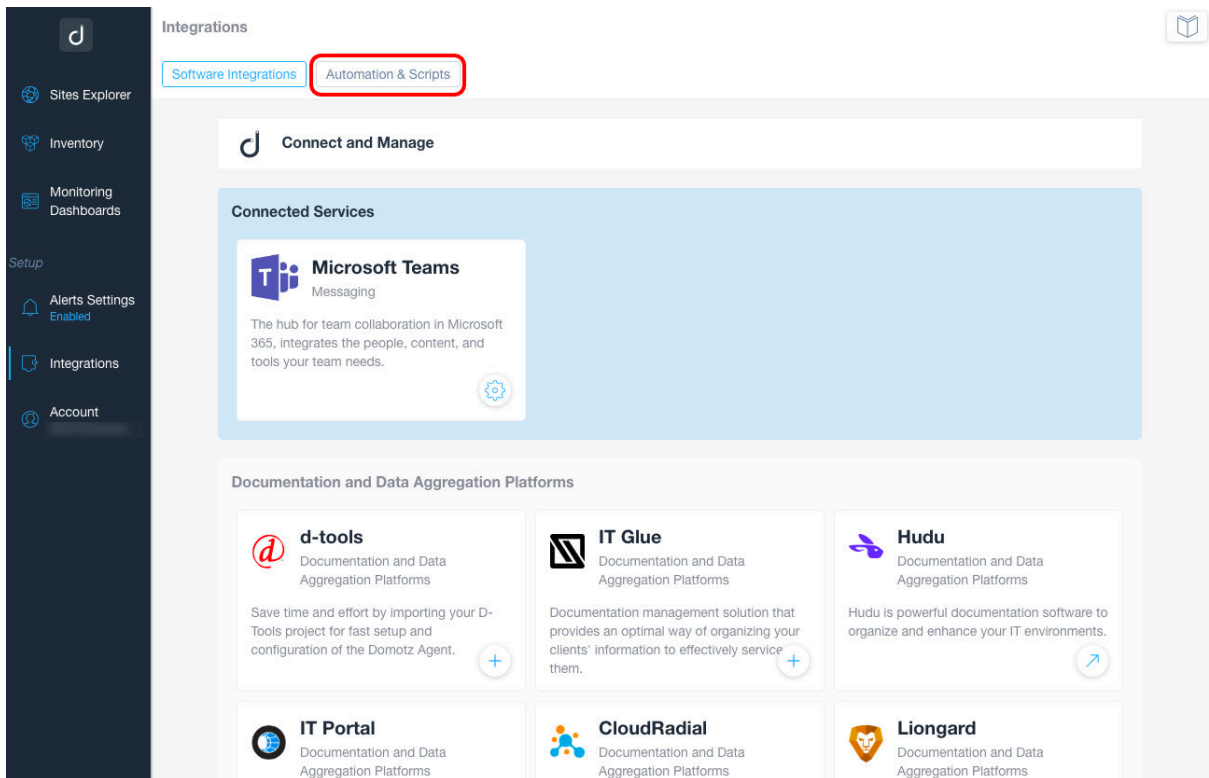
With the Username, API Key and URL, you can now setup the Script in Domotz:

From Integrations, select in the top bar **Automation & Scripts**



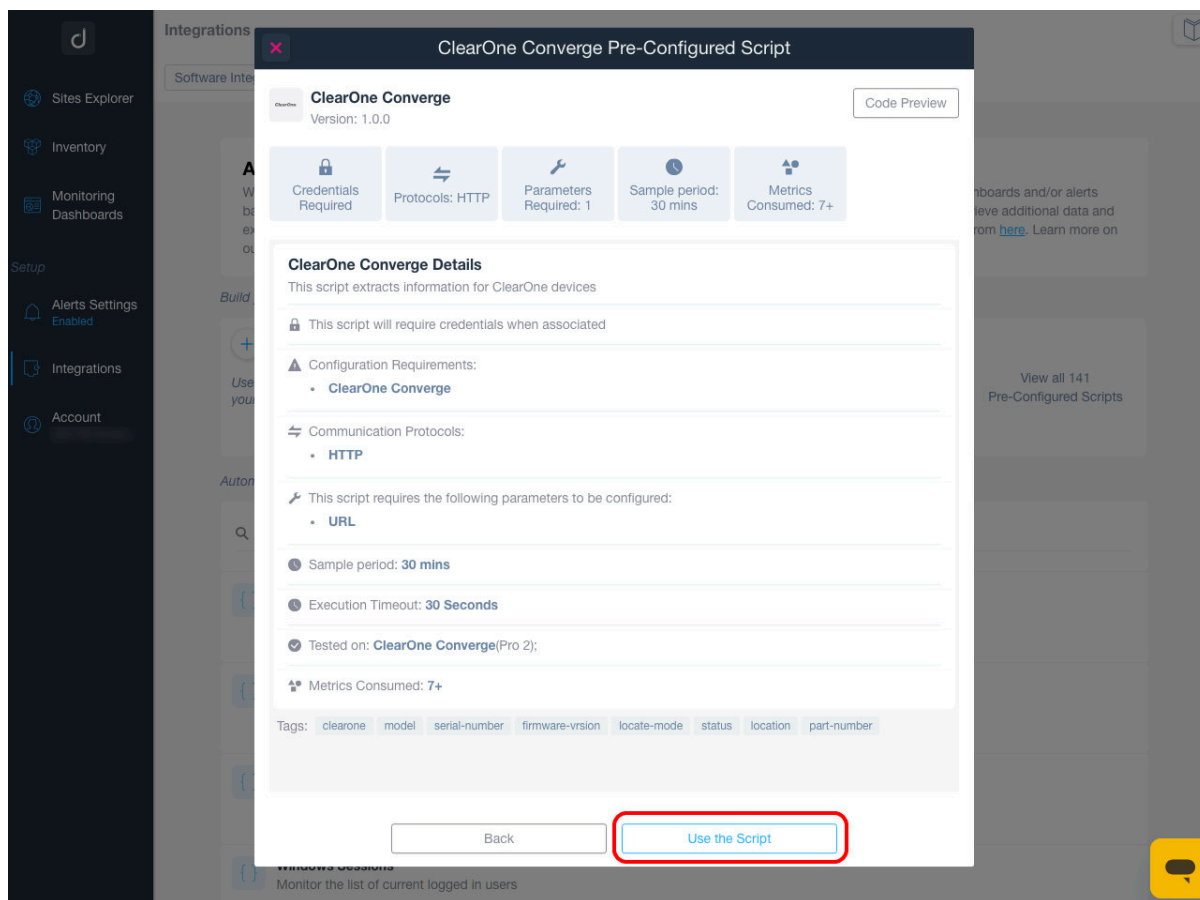

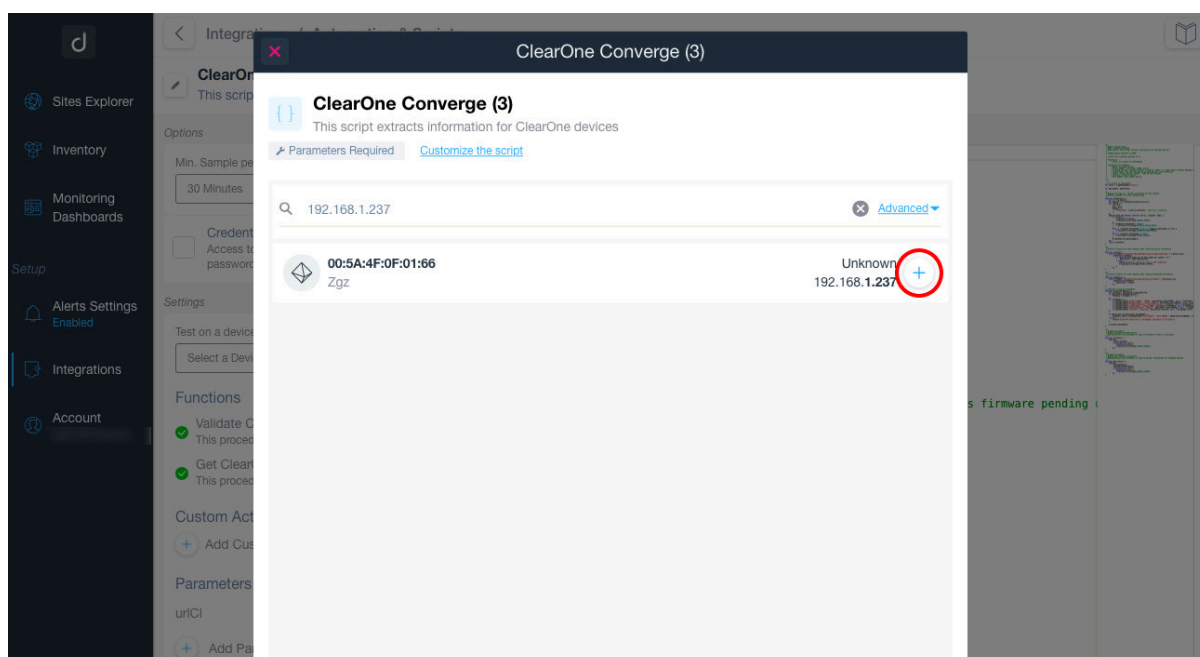
## Search “ClearOne” and select the Script

From the ClearOne Script, press **Use the Script** for select the devices to apply



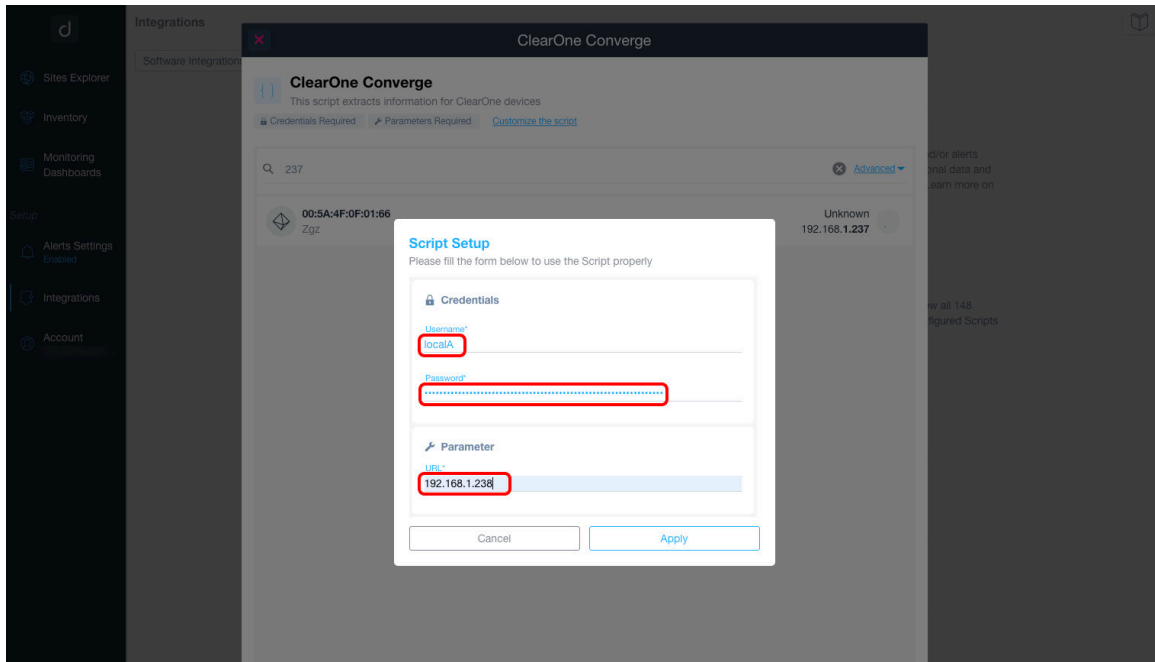
It's possible to search by different fields and add as many ClearOne devices as you want. For every device you press on the button +



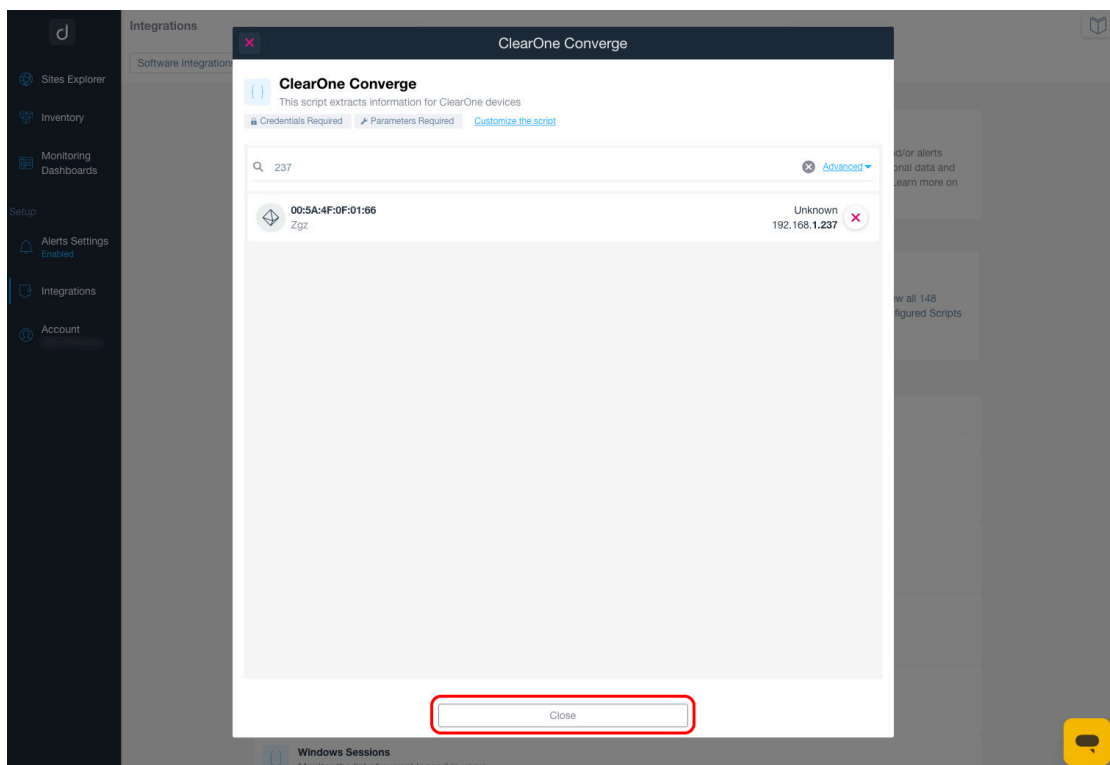
In the next dialog, you should fill the username, password and URL. You should fill with this information:

- Username: User of CONVERGENCE Local Agent used for Login
- Password: API Key obtained from CONVERGENCE Admin Web.
- URL: Just the IP of the CONVERGENCE Local Agent.

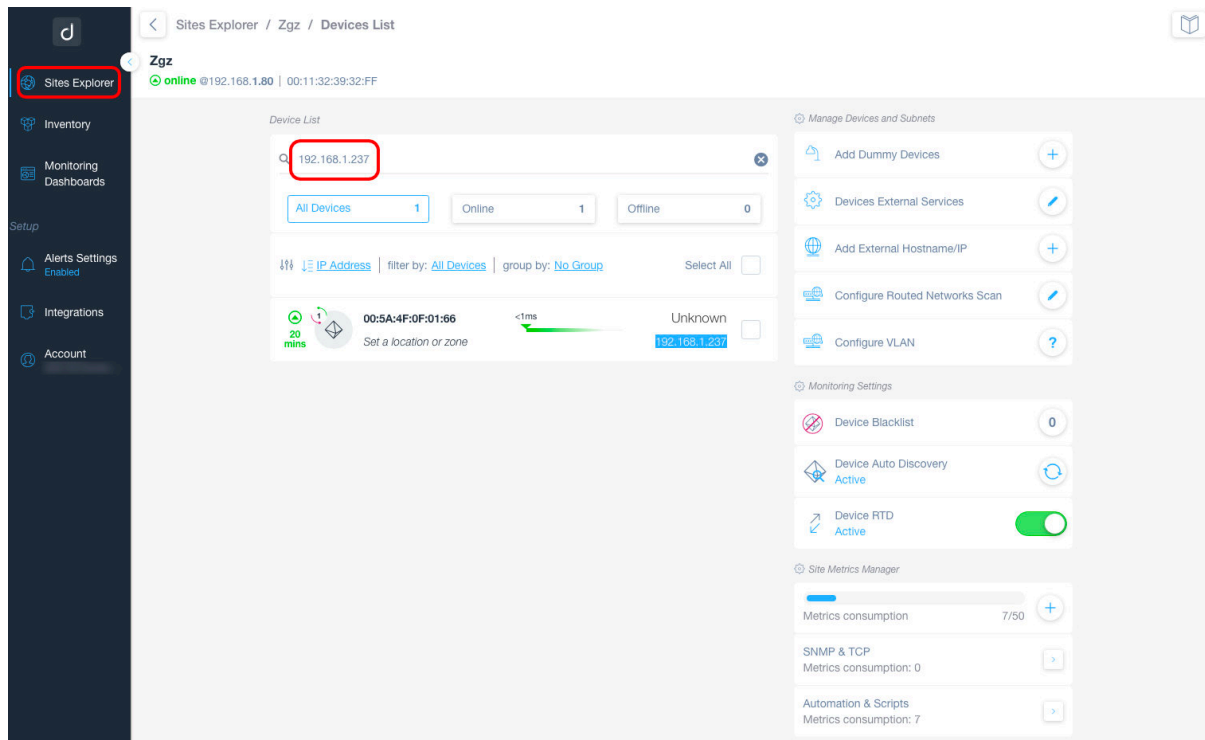
With the information entered, press the button **Apply**



Once added, we can close the dialog and we can go to Sites Explorer.



From **Sites Explorer**, we select our location and search the device where script has been applied.



From the device we can select the **Scripts** tab and we should watch the information provided by the script
